

Standard lens enhancements

· Solid tints and dyes

They aren't just for fashion. They help reduce the amount of light that can enter the eyes through lenses.

Plastic gradient dyes

This treatment creates an effect where lenses are darker at the top and gradually lighten toward the bottom.

· Scratch-resistant coating

A film or coating that protects plastic lenses from scratching and pitting — leading to longer lasting, clearer lenses.

· Anti-reflective coating

This lens treatment helps prevent distracting glare and eye fatigue. It reduces the amount of light reflecting off the lens surface, making the lenses appear clearer. The eyes are also more visible behind the lenses.

Ultraviolet protection

A treatment that is built into and applied to lenses as a coating to help filter out harmful rays from the sun. The process helps block 98–100% of transmitted and reflected UVA and UVB rays.

• Polycarbonate lenses

The lens material is thinner, lighter and harder to break than standard plastic. Under our plans, polycarbonate lenses are the standard for children's eyewear. Plus, they provide UV protection and are scratch resistant.

Photochromic lenses

They are great for convenience and style. They darken when exposed to sunlight and lighten away from it.

• Progressive lenses

Bifocal or multifocal lenses with no visible lines where the lens power gradually changes from distance to near.
